Task Information:

 - A Collage using: photo, paper, cloth, drawing, paint, other...
 - A Drawing using: pencil, watercolour pencil, chalk pastel, oil pastel, charcoal ...
 - A Painting Acrylic, watercolour
 - A Sculpture Clay, assemblage, reduction, found object, metal, wood, cement etc.
 - Wearable Art See the teacher
 - Collection of works 2 or 3 small versions of different mediums of the above.






Painting Sculpture
