- You are able to bring in a summary sheet into the exam (this will be completed in class).

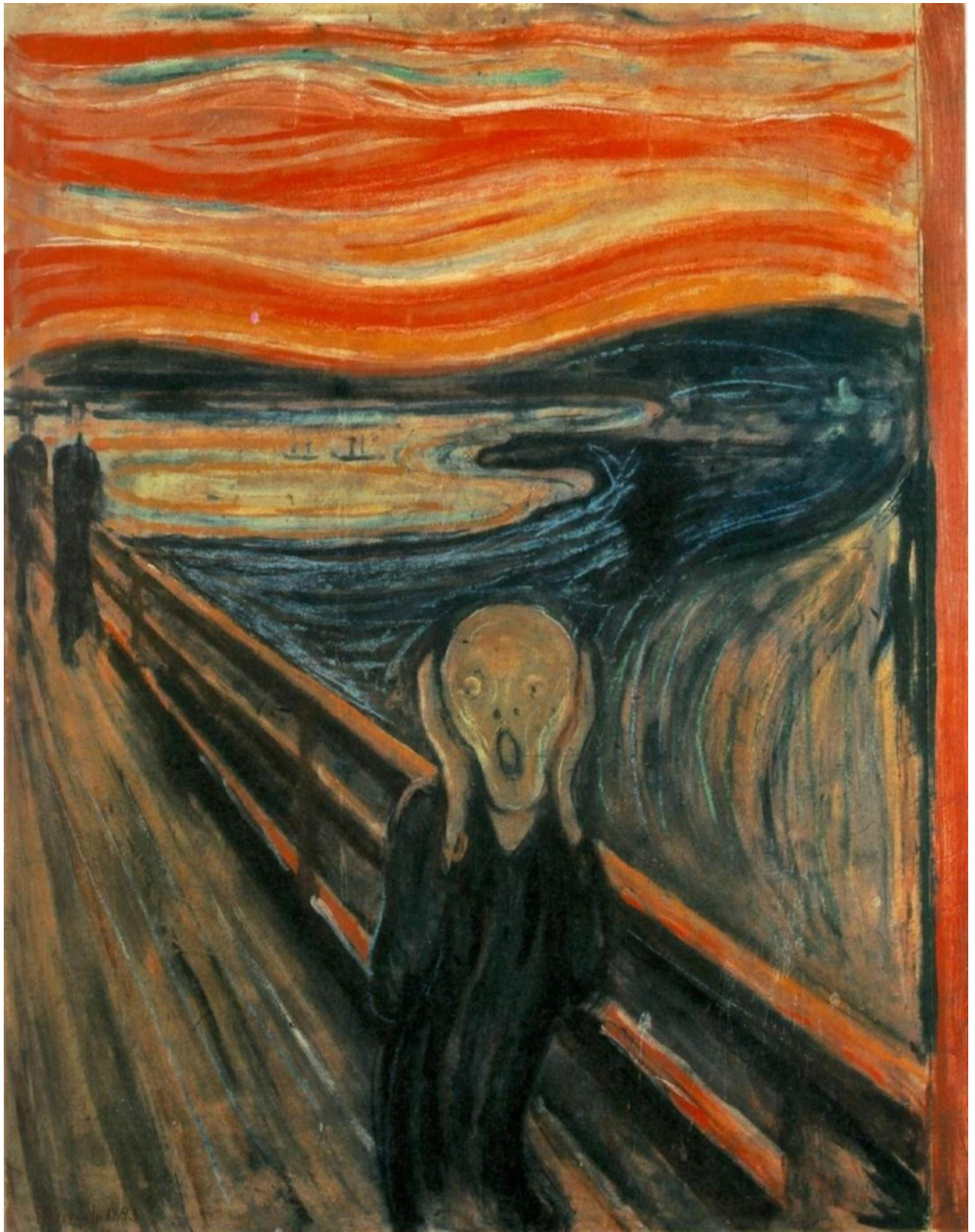

5. Writes a conclusion that summarises the essay's main points and ties the parts of the essay together.	/2
