Assessment Criteria

In this task, you will be assessed on how well you:

- Investigate a current workplace by selecting a media report.
- Discuss how employers can demonstrate commitment to diverse workplaces.
- Examine rapidly changing work arrangements and reasons for the change which include globalisation and technological innovation.

Task Information: Video Report & Rationale

Part 1. Video Report (15 Marks)

Using a **case study** and referencing at least **ONE** relevant media resource that you have researched yourself; you are required to create a video using **MovieMaker, Animoto or iMovie** or any other presentation software on the various aspects a transnational corporation (TNC) has taken to improve their workplaces.

Scaffold:

You will need to provide relevant information for each of the following:

1. Globalisation

- Define this term
- How and why has your chosen TNC embarked on global expansion?

2. Technology

- Define this term
- How does your chosen TNC use technology?

3. Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)

- Define this term
- Does your chosen TNC follow through on their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)?

4. Diversity

- Is your chosen TNC successful in promoting diversity in the workplace?

5. Bibliography

- Include your chosen media resource as well as at least four websites and/or books which you have used to gather your information from. Copy and paste the direct web address and/or title and author of the book you have used in your research.

This assessment task may be completed in pairs or individually.

Part 2. Rationale (5 marks)

You will be required to submit a copy of **AT LEAST ONE current and relevant media resource that you used in part 1** (e.g. newspaper article, interview transcript, online article etc) that you have sourced for your report. **You will need to write a 150–200-word rationale** explaining your decision for selecting this media report. If working in pairs, each person is to submit their own rationale.

ICT & Presentation Guidelines (10 marks)

- You will be assessed on your overall presentation. Consider, colour, creativity, originality, visual appeal, ability to read and understand your information easily.
- Use an appropriate font size and style when writing information.

Include the following:

- Music or background sounds
- Voice recording of information (**at least 4 minutes of speaking per group member**)
- Text containing key points
- At least two labelled pictures, diagrams and/or charts
- Divide your information in the video into clearly defined sections such as Globalisation, Technology, Corporate Social Responsibility and Diversity
- You do not have to appear in your video, but there must be audio of your voice throughout
- Individual videos must be **at least 5 minutes long**. Pair submissions must be **at least 8 minutes long**

Instructions and Submission Requirements

- You must refer to the marking criteria to ensure you meet the content (research) and ICT (technology) requirements of the task.
- If working on this task in pairs, you must ensure that all members have equal input into the creation of the task and each student makes at least a 4 minute voice recording relating to the task content to receive the marks.
- To hand this task in, you must upload it to the Work Education Google Classroom Assessment Task dropbox. If you are using an online platform such as Animoto, submit a copy of your video link on Google Classroom (Do not just hand in the Animoto home page link).
- Failure to do this by the due date will be deemed as non-submission and will attract a zero mark.

This task is part of your formal assessment for this subject. Tasks not submitted on the due date will be awarded zero.
