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## **Georges River College Transition Program** **YEAR 10 into 11 SUBJECT INFORMATION DAY**

Georges River College Oatley Senior Campus is committed to ensuring transition from middle school to senior school is informative and explicit. Transition programs impact a young person's engagement with school, their wellbeing and ongoing learning trajectory. Our aim is to increase the number of transition sessions by providing more experiences for parents and students to visit GRC Oatley Senior Campus over a 6 month period.

During Term 2, Year 10 students from the Middle Campuses of Georges River College have been offered a range of activities to help them make an informed decision about the subjects they wish to study in Year 11 and 12. These include:

- **Subject Taster classes**
- **Subject Information Day** – Students only.  
Staff from GRC Oatley Senior Campus will be providing advice on this day regarding course content, assessment, resource requirements, time considerations and particular attributes needed to achieve success in each subject.
- **Subject Information Night** – Parents and students are invited to attend.

- **Curriculum Expo** – Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 (4 – 7pm).
- Further information will be provided by GRC Middle Campuses.

It is critical that students are provided with consistent information regarding subjects, so that they not only choose subjects that they like and are capable of achieving success in but subjects that will gain them the qualifications they aspire to. Once students begin a subject in Year 11, it is very difficult to change to another subject, as available spaces are limited and NESA requires a certain amount of hours of study to complete the Year 11 Preliminary Course.

**Our Subject Information Day is scheduled for Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2018 at Georges River College Oatley Senior Campus. Students will be expected to make their own way to and from the venue. Student are required to be at GRC Oatley Senior Campus at 9.45am for roll marking and be dismissed by 2:40pm. They will be supervised by staff from our Middle campuses.
