Year 9 Yearly Examinations 2018

Information for Students

- Examinations will be held in the hall (except when indicated elsewhere). Some elective exams may be held during timetabled class time. Students must line up in alphabetical order as directed outside the hall.
- Yearly exams are a compulsory part of your assessment. If you are ill on the day of an examination, you
 must provide a medical certificate outlining your illness to the school. You will be required to complete
 any outstanding exams at a time negotiated with the Head Teacher of the faculty administering the exam.
- Full school uniform is to be worn at all times (including sports uniform on Wednesdays). If you are not in school uniform, you may not be permitted to enter the hall for your examination.
- Attendance at Sport on Wednesday is Compulsory
- Upon entering the hall, you are under exam conditions. You will be reminded of the examination conditions prior to the examination commencing. Maintaining the integrity of all exams is vital. You are not permitted to communicate with your peers under any circumstances. If you communicate with your peers or exhibit disruptive behaviour whilst under examination conditions, you may be required to leave the hall and a zero mark may be recorded for your exam.
- Cheating of any kind may also result in you being required to leave the hall and a zero mark being recorded for your exam. Non attempts or non serious attempts at an examination may also result in a zero mark being recorded for your exam

Ensure that you have the necessary equipment with you as borrowing will not be permitted.

- -Approved Scientific Calculator and geometric equipment (compasses, protractor, set squares) for Mathematics, Science, History and Geography.

No other electronic devices are to be brought into the examination room. This includes mobile phones, Ipods, mp3s, any bluetooth device and electronic translators.
