Therefore, you must be prepared to write in any one of the three text types listed above. Scaffolds of each text type and examples will be provided in class. Time Allowed: One lesson (50 minutes). Within these 50 minutes you will be given planning time and editing time to guide your time management. IMPORTANT: This task is part of your formal assessment in this subject. Tasks not completed on the due date will have 20% of marks deducted for each day late. If you are sick on the due date, you will have to provide a <u>medical certificate</u> or note from parent/guardian to support your appeal. The medical certificate or parental note will need to be presented to Mr Zouroudis or your teacher on the morning of the first day you are back at school.
