TASK - VIDEO STIMULUS & TOPIC TEST

FORMAT OF EXAMINATION:

- Multiple choice.
- Short answer responses.
- Extended response questions.

STUDY AND PREPARATION:

Please ensure you take your health book home and study its contents. See your teacher if you have any questions. Students are also encouraged to use their google classroom.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU ARE ABSENT:

If you are absent on the date of your assessment you must see your teacher or Mr Morley (HT PDHPE) on the first day that you are back at school with a medical certificate. Your teacher will then discuss with you when you will sit your rescheduled assessment. Students should come prepared to complete the missed assessment on the day they return.

LATE SUBMISSION OF ASSESSMENT TASKS:

Apart from exceptional circumstances, all work must be submitted on time. If a student knows that they will be absent on the due date of the tasks, they <u>MUST</u> complete the task on the due date.

Tasks submitted/completed after the due date without certification will result in a 20% deduction of possible marks per day late:
