Part 2. Rationale (5 marks)

You will be required to submit a copy of **AT LEAST ONE current and relevant media resource that you used in part 1** (e.g. newspaper article, interview transcript, online article etc) that you have sourced for your report. **You will need to write a 150–200-word rationale** explaining your decision for selecting this media report.

ICT & Presentation Guidelines

- You will be assessed on your overall presentation. Consider, colour, creativity, originality, visual appeal, ability to read and understand your information easily.
- Use an appropriate font size and style when writing information
- Include the following:
 - Music or background sounds
 - Voice recording of information (**at least 4 minutes of speaking per group member**)
 - Text
 - Pictures
- You do not have to appear in your video, but there must be audio of your voice throughout
- Individual videos must be **at least 5 minutes long**. Pair submissions must be **at least 8 minutes long**
- If working in pairs, each person is to **submit their own 150-200 word rationale**

Instructions and submission requirements

- You must refer to the marking criteria to ensure you meet the content (research) and ICT (technology) requirements of the task.
- To hand this task in, you must upload it to the Work Education Google Classroom Assessment Task dropbox. Failure to do this by the due date will be deemed as non-submission and will attract a zero mark.

IMPORTANT:

This task is part of your formal assessment for this subject. Tasks not submitted on the due date will be awarded zero. If you are sick on the due date you will have to provide appropriate documentation such as a parent letter or medical certificate to support your appeal.
