Topic: Focus Artwork Concept/Subject: Self and Identity OR topic of your choice (discussed with and approved by your class teacher) Theory/Related artist: student choice

Medium: At least three different 3 mediums must be used in at least 3 different art works.

Syllabus outcomes:

- 5.1 develops range and <u>autonomy</u> in selecting and applying visual arts conventions and procedures to make artworks
- 5.4 investigates the world as a source of ideas, concepts and subject matter in the visual arts
- 5.6 demonstrates developing technical accomplishment and refinement in making artworks.

Task Information:

Artworks can communicate ideas about **time**, **place** and **culture**. With this in mind, you are to make a series of related artworks that speaks about you: how you see yourself and your world.

To do this you will:

- a) Create 3 focus artworks in at least 3 different media (chosen from the list below)
 - **Digital** photograph, Photoshop, animation, video.
 - **Collage** using: photo, paper, cloth, drawing, paint, other...
 - **Drawing** using: pencil, watercolour pencil, chalk pastel, oil pastel, charcoal ...
 - Painting Acrylic, Watercolour
 - Sculpture Clay, assemblage, reduction (stone etc.), found object, metal, wood, cement etc.
 - Wearable Art

Your focus artworks should show conceptual strength and meaning as well as a high degree of material resolution.

- b) Support work, experimentation and planning is to be included in your VAD.
- c) Using the **Conceptual Framework** study the work of <u>2 artists</u> related to your art making and complete a critical analysis comparing their art making with your own – 800 words. One of the artists must use APPROPRIATION in their artmaking practice. Present this research and analysis in your VAD.

VAD – lead up work, experimentation, planning 5 marks	All written concepts, sketches and media experimentation are to be presented in your VAD. A half-page written statement that documents the processes you used to create your artwork.
Research and analysis of related artist	Research and analysis on a related artist using the Conceptual Framework presented in your VAD.
