TERM 3, 2021 - YEAR 9 POETRY EXAMINATION

The Year 9 English Poetry Examination will be held online in **Week 9 on Thursday Period** 2 for all classes, including those who do not have English scheduled in the period.

In this exam, you will be required to carefully consider a variety of previously studied poetry and/or song lyrics from the Year 9 Poetry Booklet to answer multiple choice and short response questions. There will also be an unseen component, meaning a poem that you have not studied in class.

You will be required to:

- Analyse poetry.
- Identify and discuss poetic devices, including similes, metaphors, personification, onomatopoeia, repetition, alliteration, assonance, hyperbole, rhyme and rhythm.
- Demonstrate an understanding of tone, mood and meaning in a range of poems.
- Demonstrate literal and figurative understanding of poetry.
- Identify the relevant themes and the poet's purpose.

Important Note:

This exam will take place online through a Google Form quiz. You have the one allocated period to complete and submit your answers.

In extenuating circumstances, if you are absent from the exam, a medical certificate must be provided to Mr Zouroudis. All technological failures require documented evidence and must be reported immediately to the Head Teacher. Failure to do so will result in a zero mark being awarded.
